What can you spend your NDIS funding on?

Consider the following things when deciding what to buy with your NDIS funding.

You have choice and control about what supports and services you need to achieve your goals, where and when they are provided and by whom. Some participants ask family or friends to help them make these decisions, while others may ask their ECEI Coordinator, LAC or Support Coordinator for help.

Yes	No	Will the support or service help you to achieve the goals in your NDIS plan?
Yes	No	Is the cost of the support or service reasonably priced and is it best value for money compared to other supports?
Yes	No	Can you afford the support or service within your approved NDIS budget? Remember, your funding needs to last the entire period of your plan.
Yes	No	Will the support or service help you to improve how you connect to your local community and improve the relationships you have with family and friends? It should not replace supports that would usually be provided by family, friends and within your community.
Yes	No	Is the support or service something that should be funded by other government services instead? For example, dental, health or hospital services, education, housing and public transport are all provided through other government services. Remember, all communities should have facilities and activities that are inclusive and accessible to people with disability.
Yes	No	Will the support or service help you to participate in activities with friends and other members of your community, or help you to find or keep a job?
Yes	No	Is it safe? Your supports and services should not cause you any harm or put other people at risk.

All blue boxes should be selected when deciding on what to buy with your NDIS funding.
